

The new Jose Aponte de la Torre Airport (JATA) is a first class facility with a modern and comfortable passenger terminal. These facilities have 16,000sq. foot for common use space, a cafeteria and public parking. Access road to the terminal is illuminated by a photovoltaic system. Air conditioning and lights on the runway are controlled and monitored by an automated system. It is named after a prominent mayor of the city of Carolina, town located on the East coast, who vehemently fought for the transfer of the old Roosevelt Road Naval Station to the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico.

The airport and all of its facilities, located on 124 acres, were transferred on February 7, 2008 by means of an agreement between the United States Defense Department and the Puerto Rico Ports Authority. JATA features a 11,000 feet runway, the second longest in the Caribbean, being Aguadilla's runway the first.

**OPERATIONS**

All services and operations from Fajardo Airport were transferred without disruption to JATA. Rescue and Firefighting Unit and Customs are installed on modern facilities. Puerto Rico Police and the State Emergency Agency will locate their regional Eastern offices at Ceiba's airport. As part of the Capital Improvement Program, \$20 million dollars were invested on this fist phase of the airport's rehabilitation projects. This Program proposes a total investment of \$418 million dollars up to year 2027.

**GROUND TRANSPORTATION**

The Public Service Commission and the car transportation services from Fajardo and Ceiba announced an agreement to keep the actual rate of \$3.00 (per person, with a minimum of four passengers) to cover the new route between Ceiba's Airport and the bus terminal at Fajardo. This agreement guarantees that the transportation prices will not increase.
